Special City Council Meeting on 89A Lights & Safety
Wednesday, August 13, 4:30PM
City Hall

We ask you all to attend to be heard about lights on 89A in West Sedona.

This is the date we have been waiting for -- a special City Council meeting when ADOT will make their proposal to the Council about how to resolve the safety issues on Highway 89A. We urge you all to be there in force to show the will of the community. In general, the will of the community is to not put up street lights on 89A. Keep Sedona Beautiful's position has been that lights are the least effective measure to put in place -- we urge the City Council and ADOT to put in the traffic signal and crosswalk at Andante, lower the speed limit, continue stepped-up enforcement (which has already shown a 40% decrease in injuries and no fatalities in 2007), bring 89A side business lighting into compliance, and improve public education.
