The **Sirius Lookers Astro Club, Sedona Public Library, and Keep Sedona Beautiful, Dark-Sky Committee** are sponsoring the National Astronomy Day this year on April 26th, Sunday. An event that is now global, starting over 30 years ago by Doug Berger of California for promoting science, and dark sky awareness in the public's eye.

The **free star party** will be at the Safeway Plaza in West Sedona, starting with (SAFE) solar viewing of our closest star, the "Sun". See explosions coming off the Sun with a H-alpha filtered scope and sunspots! The solar viewing will be from 3:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.
