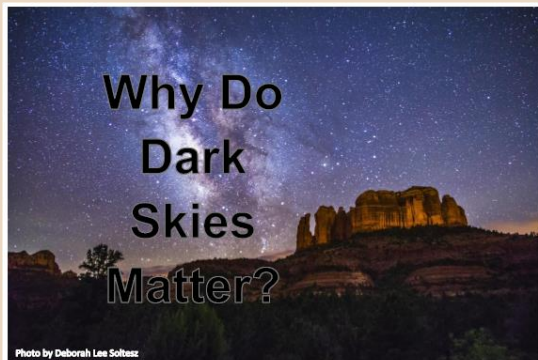

Why should we turn out the lights at night and enjoy the darkness? Why is it important that we protect our nighttime views of the starry sky? Some philosophers argue that the darkness of night is a gift that helps to restore our moral sense. In this talk we will discuss what connections can be found between darkness and the night sky with our sense of morality, our sense of who we are as human beings, and our understanding of our place in the universe. Dr. Matthew Goodwin is senior lecturer at Northern Arizona University's Department of Philosophy, an Arizona Humanities Road Scholar, and co-founder of Sedona Philosophy—an Arizona Benefit Corporation. The Sustainability Alliance today announced that they will host a forum of the candidates running for Sedona Mayor and City Council in the August 28, 2018, primary election. The forum will be held at 1:00pm on Saturday, July 28, 2018, at the Mary D. Fisher Theater, 2030 W State Route 89A, Sedona, AZ 86336. The public is invited and there is no charge for admission.

The theme of the forum will be "sustainability": candidates will be asked to respond to questions on this theme, in addition to being given time to introduce themselves and explain their reasons for seeking public office. All three Sedona Mayoral and nine City Council candidates have been invited to participate and will be given equal opportunity to speak. The moderator for the forum will be Andrea Christelle, Ph.D., founder and owner of Sedona Philosophy.
