

KSB Pushmataha Room *remodel 2018*

Keep Sedona Beautiful (KSB) has finished a remodeling project assisted by local interior designer Lisa Snowden owner of Snowden Design. The project covered both the KSB meeting room and the smaller conference room. The top-to-bottom project included replacing all lighting and fans, repainting walls, replacing old single pane windows with energy efficient double panes, recarpeting, replacing old wooden room dividers, and procuring new chairs. KSB also replaced our aging audio-visual equipment.

Our rooms now seem significantly larger, brighter and more contemporary. With improved lighting, ventilation and chairs, the space is also much more comfortable.

The greater Sedona area has few options for affordable meeting space for organizations and groups that lack their own facilities. This remodel brings our rentable space up to the standards of costlier facilities especially those available through local area hotels.

We would like to call out the significant generosity of Sedona Home & Design Center who donated the labor for installation of carpet. Top Coat Painting discounted the labor needed to repaint our walls, and Baldovin Electric discounted the labor needed to replace lights and ceiling fans. The Glass Company from Cottonwood supplied bathroom mirrors at a discount. We also wish to thank the following local vendors for their service: Sedona Window & Doors replaced windows, Window Wonders supplied the blinds, and Wired-up Systems installed new AV equipment.

Greater Sedona area litter lifting assignments currently open:

- SR 179 Mile 302 to 303 - South of Beaverhead Flat Road
- SR 179 Mile 303 to 304 - North of Beaverhead Flat Road
- SR 179 Mile 308W to 309W - southbound near Bell Rock
- SR 179 Mile 309 E to 310E - northbound near Little Horse Trailhead
- SR 179 Mile 312 to 313
- Beaverhead Flat Rd. Mile 6 - West of the SR 179 intersection
- Forest Rd 618 from I-17 to Beaver Creek - East of SR 179
- Posse Grounds Rd. North of 89A

All equipment is provided. Temporary positions and route sharing or partnering options are also available.





Tomorrow, Thursday, November 1st, at 6:30PM, Inspiration of Sedona will present a free screening of the award-winning Planetary documentary. This will be followed by an open, public discussion.

We are in the midst of a global crisis of perspective, brought on by a disconnection from Earth and from each other. We have forgotten the undeniable truth that every living thing is connected.

Planetary is a feature length documentary that expands on the mind-blowing perspective shared by astronauts and indigenous elders alike - that each and every one of us is inseparable from each other, the planet and the universe as a whole, a realization that is both humbling and comforting. It suggests that if more of us start to experience the simple truth of our interdependence and connection, there is hope for the next stage in our human journey. Meant to inspire awe and wonder by seeing things as they are, it places our individual stories in the context of the larger planetary/cosmic story.

After a long hiatus, Inspiration of Sedona is showing the Planetary documentary as the beginning of a new direction for its monthly gatherings. The intention is to present a more balanced focus on inner self-sustainability as an integral piece, (ie. peace), that is needed to inspire external environmental sustainability efforts.

As the summer ends and we start the end of the year, I would like to thank all who have joined the membership & "made great progress" with Keep Sedona Beautiful.

The last year has been active and productive for the organization, due mainly to the wonderful contributions of volunteers - both on the board and throughout the community for ongoing programs and initiatives that promote our community. Without individuals in our way to come and contribute their accomplishments, I would not have been able to continue to move forward and represent the mission of KSB.

Native Plant Workshop - through the wonderful efforts of our Native Plant Chair Nancy Spivack, this annual spring program was a resounding success. Over 120 people attended the workshop and learned through a variety of lectures and workshops about plants that thrive and originate in the region.

Dark Skies - Joanne Fender has continued to lead the Dark Sky Committee. Not only have new members joined this committee, but there is an organization recognized by the International Dark Sky Association for certifying municipalities to demonstrate how they are meeting the requirements of the International

Speaker Series - through the work of Dr. Anne VanDerwerf, the Speaker Series has finished its 10th year and continues to be one of the best examples. Each month this free presentation for the community has offered education and beauty to our community.

Litter Lifters - Bill Pompey and Carla Rostek have continued to lead the Litter Lifters and maintain the work of Litter Lifters - the oldest ongoing program of KSB. Rostek continues to coordinate the monthly litter cleanups while Bill and Carla work to find new and innovative ways to increase this program.

Grant for Litter Lifters - the generous donation from the Arizona Community Foundation will help KSB continue to support this important program.

In addition, there have been a number of ongoing issues that arose during the year including the proposed construction of a new bridge from land development issues, to lighting programs to cell tower placements. But the programs and volunteers of KSB and the community members of Sedona are the bedrock of the mission of KSB.
