

Join us on Wednesday September 11, 2019, 5:30 pm for speaker Jeff Hall, presenting "Dark Skies, New Research and New Outreach: All the News from Lowell Observatory"

A Flagstaff resident for more than 20 years, Dr. Jeffrey Hall has served as Director of Lowell Observatory since June 2010. His research at Lowell has focused on solar and stellar activity cycles, with the goal of lending an astronomical perspective to solar influences on terrestrial climate.

According to Jeff Hall,

"Lowell Observatory is planning a major expansion to its outreach programs and continues to perform cutting-edge research at its 4.3-meter Discovery Channel Telescope.



The Observatory has also been working extensively with the City of Flagstaff on a retrofit of its street light system that will preserve Flagstaff's dark skies."

Mr. Hall will talk about all these developments during the course of the evening.




