Join us on Wednesday February 12, 2020, 5:30 pm for speaker Tim Hauck, Program Manager for the Peregrine Fund's Condor Recovery Program presenting "Climate Change, Myths, & the Search for Real Solutions."

You will hear about one of the greatest conservation stories of the century at this month's Speaker Series.

According to Tim Hauck, "By the early 1980s, there were only 22 California Condors remaining in the wild and extinction was a likely reality. It was then that the effort to trap all remaining wild condors began and finally ended on Easter Sunday, 1987. On that day, the last wild California Condor was trapped and placed into captivity to begin the captive breeding program that would jumpstart the reintroduction effort."

Mr. Hauck is responsible for releases of captive-raised condors into the scenic wilds of the Vermilion Cliffs and surrounding areas as well as the day-to-day management of the wild population.

"Today, there are more than 500 condors in the world and 90 soaring over the desert and forest landscapes of the North American southwest."
